GOAL OF THE SEMESTER:

The aim is to introduce the students to the notion of public participation in urban planning. Both theory and practice of the interrelationships between town as a public space and its participative planning are covered. The students get an insight into such relevant topics as the notions of the 'urban' and the 'public', the systematic listing of the particular values of a township (including e.g. image guidelines), real estate valuation, and the issues of future urban centres, respectively. The course is carried out en bloc in a one week of intensive workshop which includes an architectural design task.
